On behalf of the World Indigenous Tourism Summit (WITS 2020), being hosted by WAITOC and WINTA, we are advising today that WITS 2020, which was scheduled to take place from April 6 – 9, will be postponed until November this year.

This has been a challenging decision, made by the organising committee after reviewing all available information from Governments and health authorities, in response to the rapidly evolving COVID-19 virus situation and recognises the evolving global medical crisis and the potential risk to the wider community stemming from the virus.

We've also taken into account the concerns of speakers, sponsors, exhibitors, stakeholders and potential attendees to commit to the summit. We feel taking a proactive approach to postpone the summit is a responsible and appropriate response to this crisis.

New dates have been secured with our venue partner, Crown Perth, for the **2nd – 5th November, 2020**. We hope you are able to attend.
